Rosalind Robinson is an Academician at the Royal West of England Academy and a member of the Society of Women Artists. She exhibits regularly in London, Bath and Bristol.

She studied Fine Art at Hornsey College of Art and Waltham Forest School of Art 1968 - 1972 and went on to train as a Scenic Artist at BBC Television Centre in White City before pursuing a long career as a mural painter, working throughout the UK, the Channel Islands, Italy and Sweden.

Rosalind now paints exclusively from her studio in Wiltshire making paintings concerned with the direct gaze and the emotive qualities of facial expressions, posing questions about time and place and suggesting a narrative.
